


CIFS (Samba) Configuration

SMB (Samba) Configuration

Open **Control Services** from the Services Menu on the left side, next click on the wrench icon at SMB and set the following values:

- NetBIOS name: Change to your company name
- Workgroup: Change to your company name
- Description: Change to your company name
- Local Master: On
- Time Server for Domain: On
- Unix Extensions: On
- Zeroconf share discovery: On
- Allow execute always: On
- Obey pam restrictions: On
